After running probably top 25 OA after Lap 1, Jeremy was WAY in the back of the pack now. He again pitted on Lap 2 for some fresh 100% Goggles. I filled him up again using our IMS Quick Fill and sent him out again. He raced hard for the next two laps and picked off a ton of riders.

He just missed going out for the 5th lap, which very few riders did, by only 2 minutes. Turns out, Jeremy took 8th in Class and 88th OA; not bad for 329 riders that entered the race. I believe there was a scoring issue, but since this was just a race for pride, I didn't make a fuss about the final results. I'm still very proud of him for pushing as hard as he did.

We're still hunting down the AMA West Hare Scrambles Championship. Jeremy currently has a 1 full race advantage over 2nd place in the points. Our next race is in a couple of weeks in Caliente NV. Stay tuned and thank you to all our sponsors who help keep this going.

#### CERA 2015 Fools Gold

The 2015 CERA Fools Gold Enduro was held on Sunday May 3<sup>rd</sup> in the El Dorado National Forest on Mace Mill Road. The event came off succesfully with only a minimal adjustments with the final Check. The top A Rider and overall winner was Austin Tavares from the Goast Riders and riding a KTM 250. His score was 7.0280. Great job!

The second place A Rider james Ptarcinski came in at 7.0148. That was closs, Also a great job!

The riders were coming in with plenty of positive comments about the course and layout and what a great job CERA had done with this years Fools Gold.

With only a few minor injuries with one being a top AA rider Jordan Brandt who managed to unload after putting in a great ride up to that point. Unfortunaley he had to retire after the get-off. He logged in zero points lost through Check # 7. We all wish him a speedy recovery.

Our rider count consisted of 122 total riders of which 40 were A.s, 27 were B's and 55 were Cs. We had two Ladies riding in the B Womens Class who did remarkably well. They bith rode on the same minute and made it from the Start to Finish. When they came through our Check #6 they were looking great and seemed to be having a fun ride at that point. The was just after coming down off of Slate Mt and pushing through the Crozier Loop area. Nice job ladies.
