Ed Cavanaugh, educator and outdoorsman had been missing in El Dorado National Forest.

On July 17, Ed Cavanaugh was riding his dirt bike in the El Dorado National Forest near Placerville, California. Cavanaugh was an Expert Wilderness Teacher and avidoutdoorsman with plenty of backcountry experience.

Note:

It has been reported that Ed's body was found south east of Slate Mountain. Apparently Ed was riding on Trail 7 (our trail called Trish's Trail) when he got off of the trail. He was eventually found about one quarter of a mile off the trail in some thick brush. His bike was found first then his body was found just a short distance away.

Speculation is the he got off of the trail at the most upper end of Trail 7 and did not make it back up on the main trail. Unfortunately, at that point he proceeded further down an old unused trail toward the North Fork Canyon and ran into complications. No further details.

So sad, may he rest in peace
